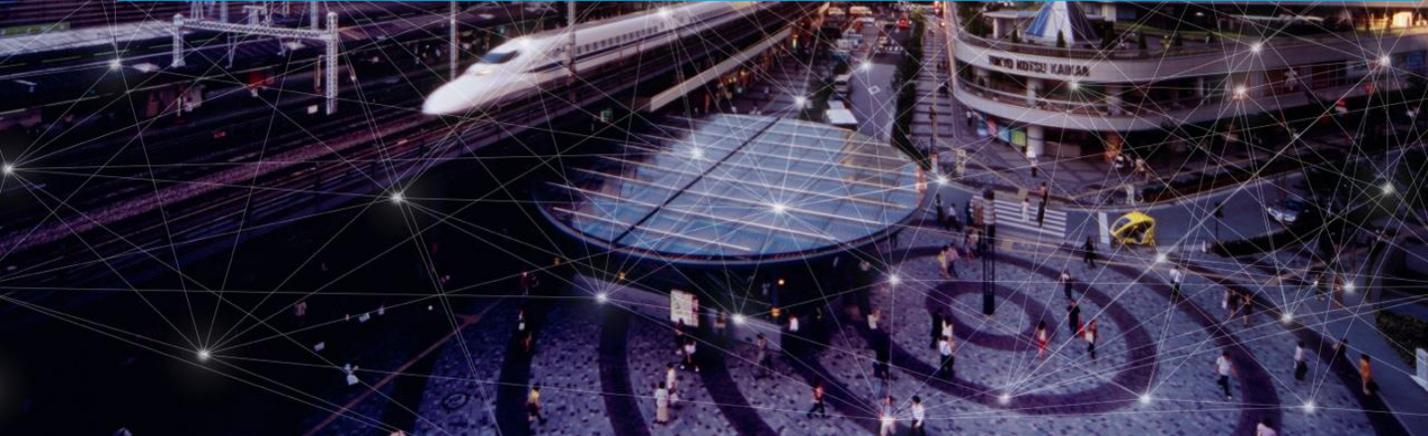


## Cisco UCS MIGRATION OSDB Migration Solution Brief

In today's competitive world of business excellence there are two reasons companies replace their HW and/or network partners. The first being end-of-life for current assets, and the second is simply to catch up with competition.

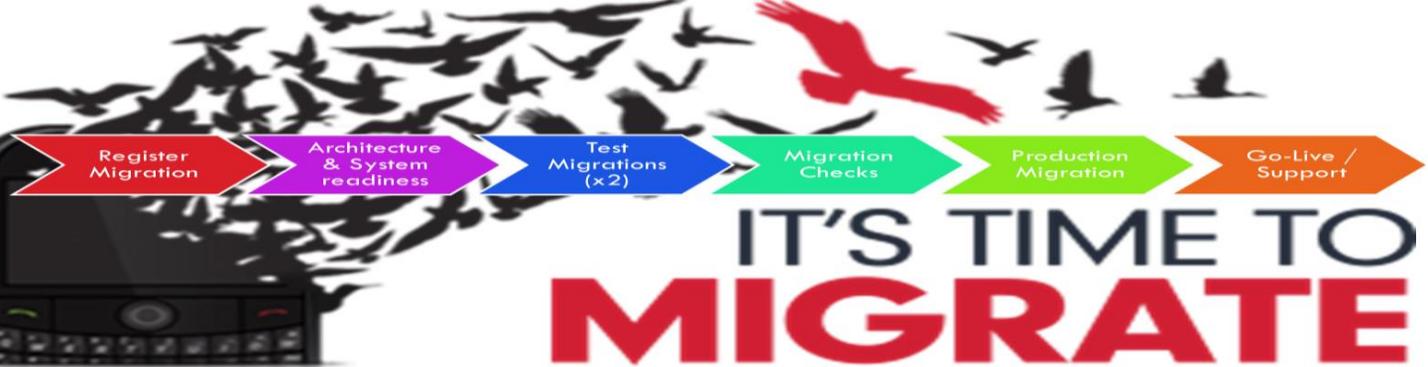
